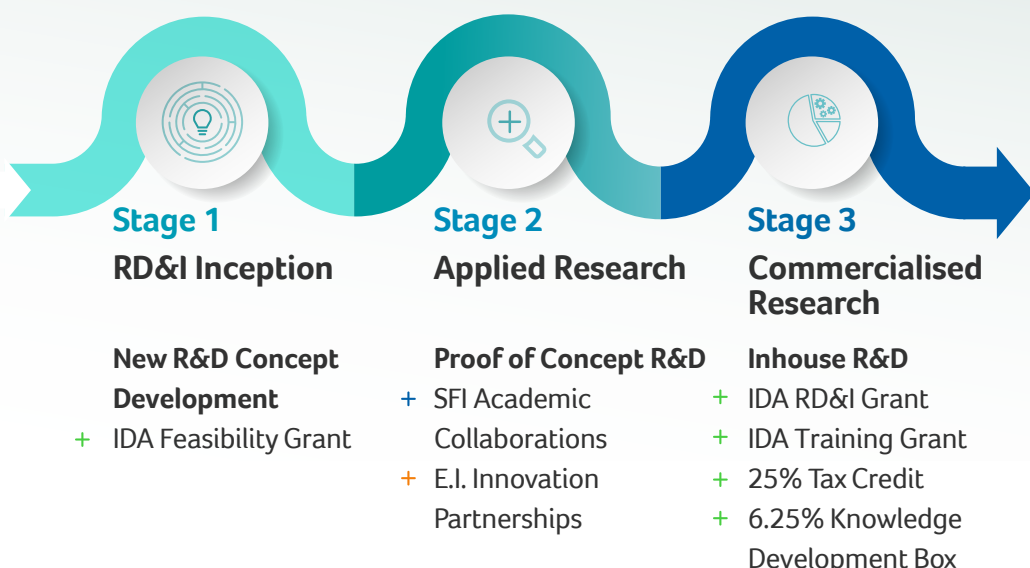

Funding Example - Total RD&I eligible expenditure

Proposed Company Project Cost €10M² of which-

- 1) €8M company expenditure is for in house R&D (via 10% grant IDA RD&I grant= €800k grant)
- 2) €2M is for a collaborative academic research project (via >50% grant SFI grant= €1M grant)

Total agency grant aid (IDA, SFI) €1.8M

25% Tax credit available on remaining eligible project expenditure of €8.2M= €2.05M

Reduced company Project cost post supports €6.15M (↓€3.85M)
